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Vessel Activity Summary

During the 6-month period from January through to July 2020, OceanMind carried out container risk analysis for seven shipments delivered to SEAPAC-Kingfisher Holdings Ltd. These analyses provide independent validation of the legality and possible risks of these shipments. <u>All risks in the analysis reports have been settled and are considered closed.</u>

Analysis was conducted on an ad-hoc bases according to when SEAPAC-Kingfisher purchased product via container shipments. The purpose of the risk analysis is to identify any potential IUU activity by the catching vessels and to provide SEAPAC-Kingfisher with recommendations for follow-up action to minimise and mitigate against risks.

The seven container shipments of frozen tuna caught by purse seine fishing vessels were assessed for possible risks using AIS analysis.

Documentation was also reviewed for consistency and compared with the observed activities on AIS. Half of fishing trips were observed in



the Western Pacific Ocean and the other half were observed in the Indian Ocean. Where appropriate, the OceanMind team supported further investigations of these vessels, including reviewing vessel logbooks and fishing licenses to confirm compliance and support investigations by SEAPAC-Kingfisher.

The legality and possible risks of these shipments were reviewed by OceanMind and can be classified into 2 event categories explained in the table below.

A total of 7 container shipments were analysed. Three shipments were tuna were caught by purse seine fishing vessels in the Western Pacific Ocean and four shipment was of tuna caught by purse seine fishing vessels in the Indian Ocean. A summary of all shipments are described below in Table 2. **All risks have been settled and are considered closed.**
